



## **CHILDREN AND RESTRAINT SYSTEMS (C.A.R.S)** **TRAINING**

**Applicants or licensed foster parents and child care providers who want to provide care and transport children eight (8) years of age and under, must obtain Child Passenger Restraint Systems Training and this training must be repeated every five years.**

This training is three hours in length involving a certified trainer approved by the Department of Public Safety.
