WHERE: Rice County Highway Building (610 20th Street NW, Faribault)

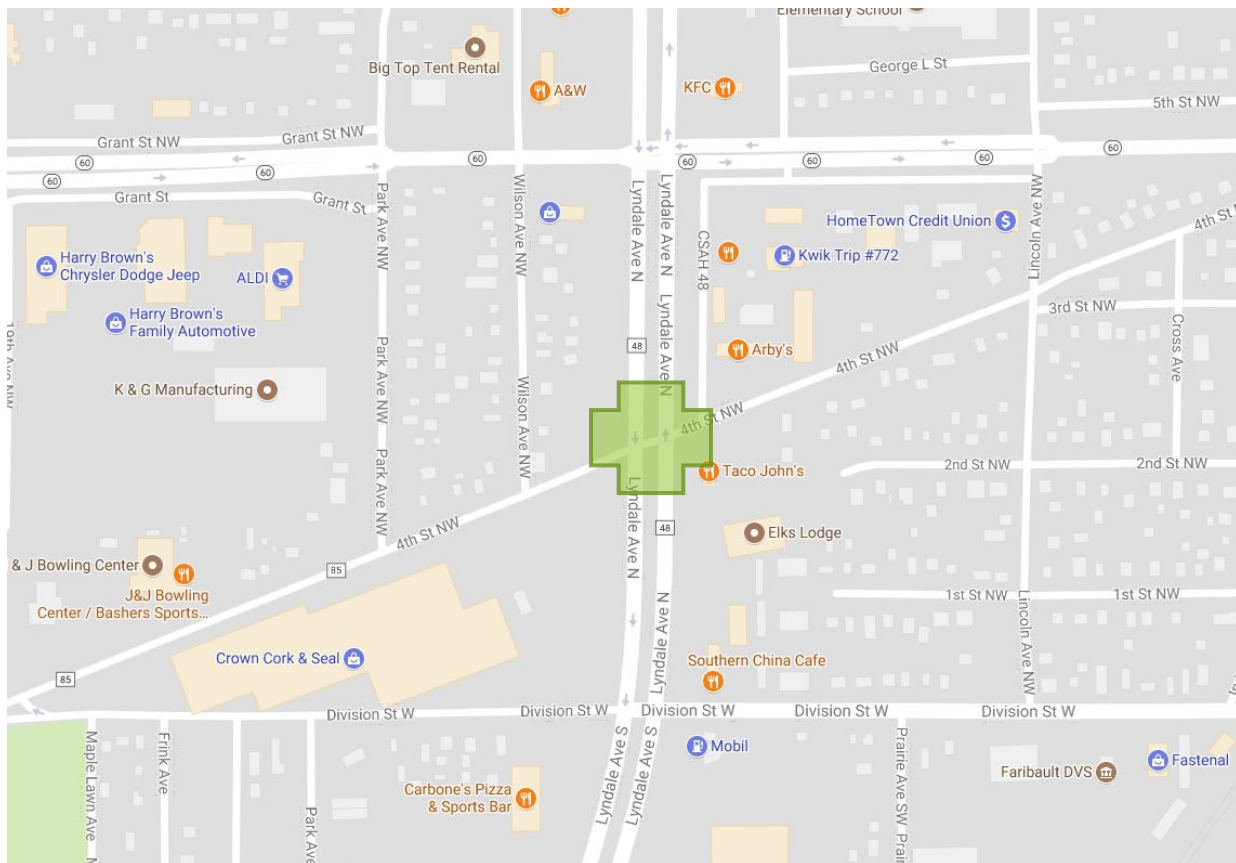
The meeting will be an open house format. Please stop by any time between 5:00 pm and 7:00 pm. There will not be a formal presentation.

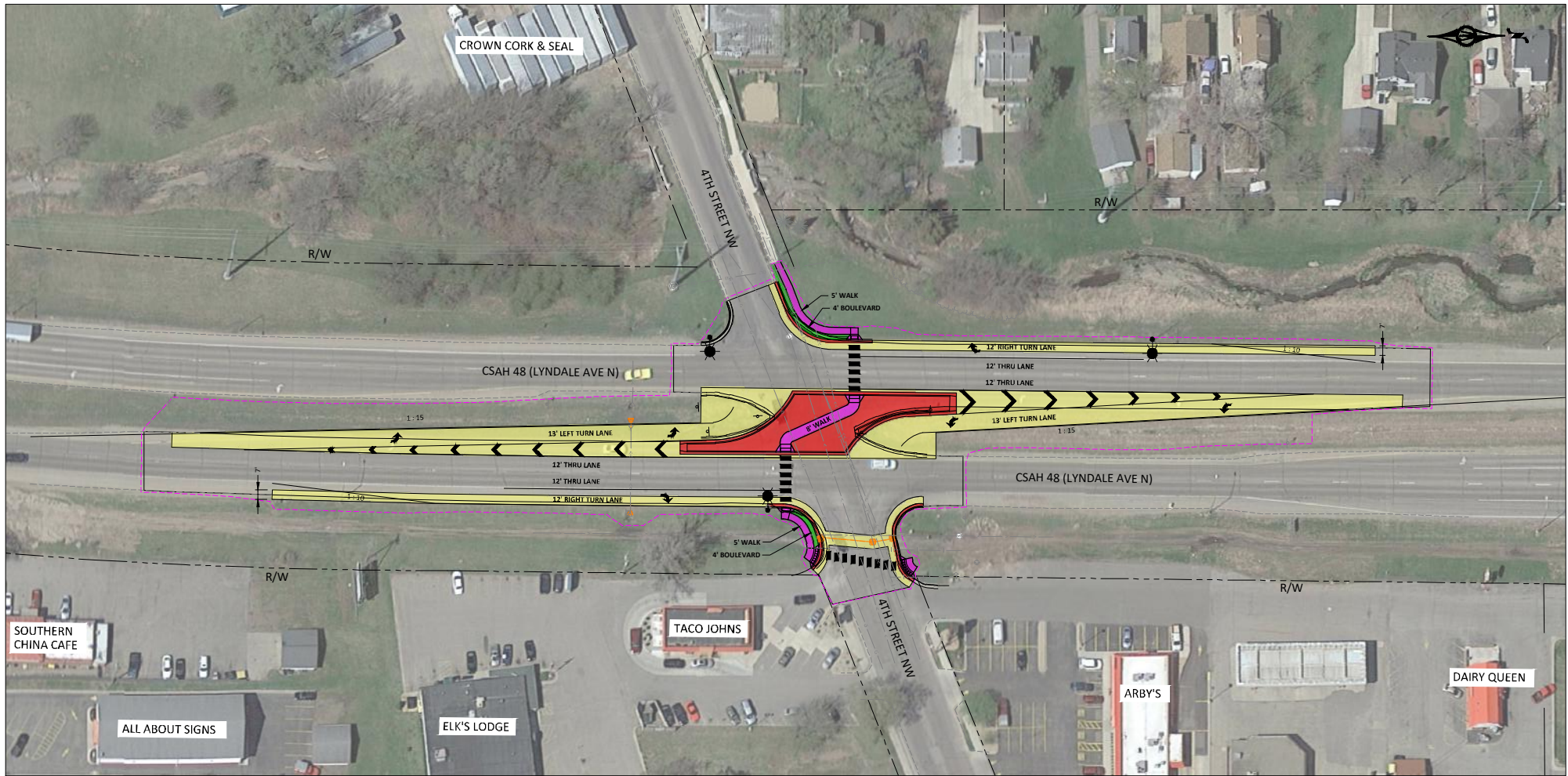
Project Purpose

CSAH 48 and 4th Street are important roadways in the City of Faribault, serving residential, commercial and industrial areas. In an effort to reduce right angle and left turn crashes, a three-quarter intersection is proposed. A three-quarter intersection eliminates the minor side-street (4th Street) left turns and through movements. While the proposed intersection configuration will prevent left turn and through movements from 4th Street, the area has good street connections to support vehicle rerouting and circulation within the local area of this intersection.
